Note:

- 1. Connection to GV-Backup Center is only supported by GV-Recording Server V1.2.4.0 or later and GV-VMS V16.10.3 or later.
- 2. GV-Redundant Server and GV-Failover Server do not support GV-VMS hosts when they are running in service mode. It is highly recommended not to enable "Service Mode" on GV-VMS.
- 3. Analog cameras are connected through GV-Video Server, GV-Compact DVR, and GV-DVR.
- 4. Software in application mode can only run when a user account is logged in, whereas software in service mode can run in the background even when no account is logged in at the moment.
- 5. Back up by schedule is not supported when connecting to GV-Recording Server.
- 6. Back up by event types is only supported when connecting to GV-DVR / NVR. You can choose to back up all events types or selected event types only (motion and/or IO events).
